

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

BERKSHIRE SS.

TO: James Olmsted, Constable of the Town of Egremont,

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth aforesaid, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Egremont qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Mount Everett Regional High School Cafeteria, in Sheffield Mass., on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at 6:00 PM, and then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$19,000.00, or any other amount, to the Highway Construction and Maintenance budget to replace funds used to finish the Mount Washington Road bridge, or to take any other action relative thereto.

(Finance Committee recommends approval, 5-yes, 1 absent.)

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$98,500.00, or any other amount, to the South Egremont School House repairs account, or to take any other action relative thereto.

(Finance Committee will make a recommendation at the Town Meeting.)

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$99,900.00, to fund a contractual obligation to a former police chief, or to take any other action relative thereto.

(Finance Committee recommends approval, 5-yes, 1 absent.)

And you are requested to warn said inhabitants of said meeting by posting copies of this Warrant in four or more public places in said Town, fourteen days at least, before the time of holding same.

Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon at or before the time of holding said meeting.
